## Your Children and Grandchildren are Covered.

If your child seems distant from faith, you have the authority, the power, the Name of Jesus, the Blood of Jesus, and the Word of God to break any bondage in their lives.

Pray these scriptures (prayers) over your children. Put their name in each verse and allow the truth of these scriptures to penetrate your heart and KNOW that what He promises, He will fulfill.



## The Promise for Your Family is for your FUTURE GENERATIONS!

“As for Me,” says the LORD, “this is My covenant with them: My Spirit who is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your descendants, nor from the mouth of your descendants’ descendants,” says the LORD, “from this time and forevermore” Is 59:21.

“I will establish my covenant as an everlasting covenant between me and you and your descendants after you for the generations to come, to be your God and the God of your descendants after you.” Genesis 17:7

## Pray These Verses Over Your Children

"The Lord bless you and keep you; The Lord make His face shine upon you, And be gracious to you; The Lord lift up His countenance upon you, And give you peace" Numbers 6:24-26.



## Pray this as a DECLARATION over Your Family

“But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord” Joshua 24:15. Your house is your entire family.

**Pray for the Lord to richly bless**, encourage, and inspire your children to teach, nurture, and raise your grandchildren in the spirit of Proverbs 22:6. “Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.”

**Pray for each grandchild’s parents’ marriage** and relationship with the Lord.

**Pray for their health**, work, and ministries that they enjoy a more grace-filled home life.

“Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, And to present you faultless Before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy. To God our Savior, Who alone is wise, Be glory and majesty, Dominion and power, Both now and forever. Amen” Jude 1:24-25.

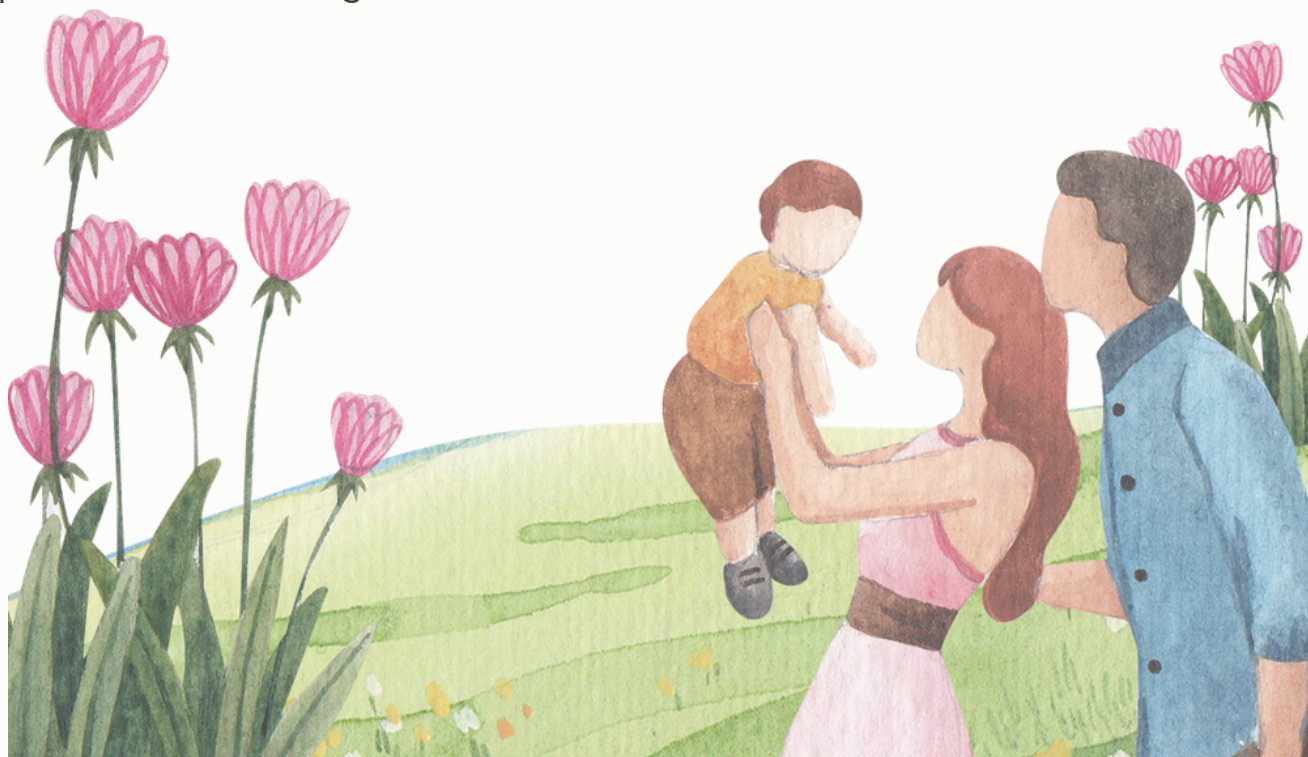
**Pray that your grandchildren** grow up to be winsome, wise, and godly young men and women who love the Lord wholeheartedly and love others well.

Pray these scriptures over them:

“They will become blameless and harmless, children of God without fault in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you shine as lights in the world, holding fast the word of life, so that I may rejoice in the day of Christ that I have not run in vain or labored in vain” Philippians 2:15-16.

“For this reason, we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God;

## Prayer of THANKSGIVING for what God has Promised You

Heavenly Father, you have promised that my children and grandchildren are protected, and I need not be worried or concerned:

“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope” Jeremiah 29:11.

“Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things” Philippians 4:6–8.

“For we (my children) are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them” Ephesians 2:10.

“And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.” Romans 8:28.

Praise God that your children will not fear but know that God has won every battle for them through our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

“Thus says the LORD to you: ‘Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s” 2 Chronicles 20:15.

“Be not afraid, only believe” Mark 5:36.

“The LORD is on my side; I will not fear. What can man do to me?” Psalm 118:6.

“For I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand, Saying to you, ‘Fear not, I will help you” Isaiah 41:13.

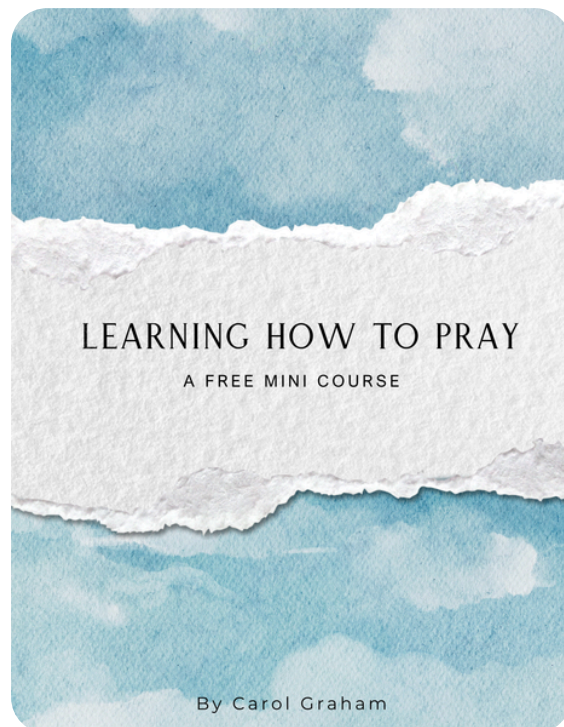
